1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this Project that appeared in UN Development Business, issue no. WB 2572-642/04 of November 16, 2004.

2. The Republic of Armenia has received a credit from the International Development Association towards the cost of Health System Modernization Project and intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments under the Contract for Renovation of "Hrazdan Hospital" Medical Center.

3. The Health Project Implementation Unit State Agency now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for "Renovation of Hrazdan Hospital Medical Center". The delivery/construction period is about 11 months.

4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits, and is open to all bidders from Eligible Source Countries as defined in the Bidding Documents.

5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Health Project Implementation Unit State Agency, 17 Shirvanzade street, 1-2 floor, Yerevan 0014, Armenia and inspect the Bidding Documents at the same address from 10:00- 13:00 and 14:00 -17:00 at local time.

6. Qualifications requirements include:

(a) an average annual financial amount of construction work implemented by the bidders in any of the last three years shall be AMD 550,000,000,

(b) the minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of the successful Bidder shall be 100,000,000 AMD,

(c) local Bidders should not have the deferred debts to Tax Inspection and Social Security State Fund.

(d) as a precondition for contract signing successful bidder along with Performance Security shall submit a Licenses for Execution of capital construction in the following spheres of civil construction: Civil works; and Energetic, Issued by the Ministry of Urban Development of the RA.

A margin of preference for eligible national contractors/joint ventures "shall not" be applied.

7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English and Armenian may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address below and upon payment of a non refundable fee AMD 65000 (or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency, by the rate on the date of transfer) for each set. The method of payment will be banktransfer. Bank account details are the following: HSBC Bank Armenia 001-141472-004 for AMD transfer or 001-141472-104 for USD transfer. The Bidding Documents will be sent by surface mail or courier airmail for overseas delivery.

8. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 12th of February, 2008 at 10:00 of local time. Electronic bidding "shall not" be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at 12th of February 2008 at 10:00 of local time.

9. All bids "shall" be accompanied by a "Bid Security" of 9,000,000 AMD.
